- Artists-authors who are members of the "Sécurité sociale des artistes-auteurs" scheme (with ID showing membership of the scheme)
- People with disabilities and one companion/carer
- Jobseekers and universal credit beneficiaries\*

- School group leaders (1 adult per 10 students / 6 pupils up to 6 years old)
- Holders of an Archi Pass
- Everyone, on the first Sunday

- Under 18-year-olds

\*ID required: (Jobseekers, proof of registration at the Pôle emploi – ASSEDIC / CMU or CMU-C certificate (Universal Health Cover / RSA payment certificate (which stands for Revenu de Solidarité Active, formerly RMI: universal credit) / ASS (Allocation Spécifique de Solidarité – jobseeker's allowance) / ATA (Allocation Temporaire d'Attente – allowance for released prisoners and asylum seekers) / AER (Allocation Equivalente Retraite – allowance for jobseekers eligible for retirement) / ASV (Allocation Supplémentaire Vieillesse) or ASPA (Allocation de Solidarité aux Personnes Âgées) – both allowances for elderly pensioners / APS (Provisional residence permit) / receipt proving that an application for refugee status has been lodged / temporary residence permit (one-year validity without work possible) / concessionary travel pass)
